For students seeking to progress their teaching qualifications, we offer an established riding school environment with a wide range of horses and riders working in all the main riding disciplines for teaching practice.

Our Facilities

With easy access from the M4 and M40, we have two indoor schools, two outdoor all-weather arenas, stabling for more than 40 horses, and approximately 100 horses on site. We have Showjumping and Cross Country courses, and easy access to off-road hacking. Our Riding School has been established for over 40 years, and provides horse riding lessons for children and adults, from beginner to advanced abilities as well as a range of activities and special events.

Working pupils may be asked to attend an interview, which may include a riding assessment depending on the level of training requested.
